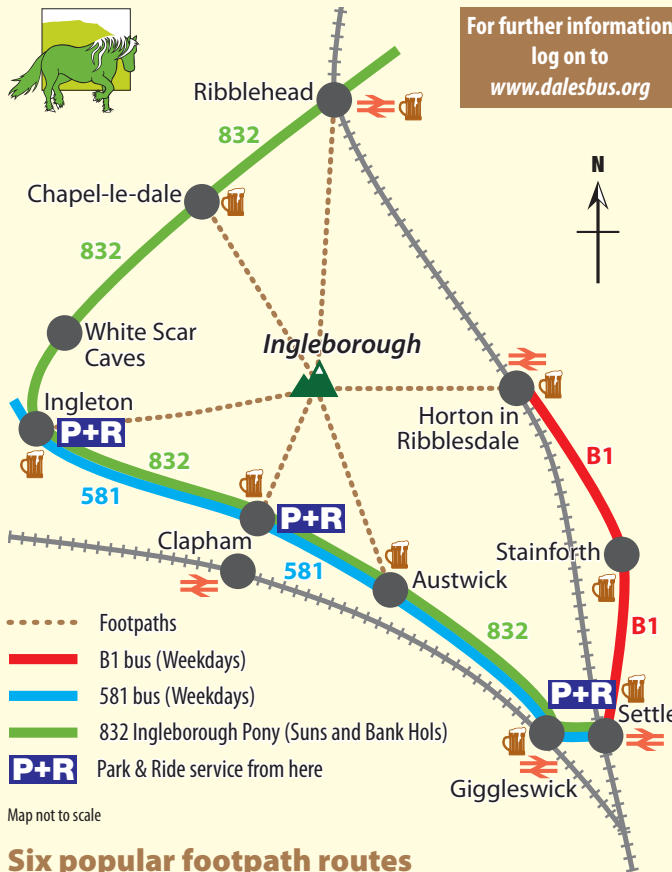

## Six popular footpath routes to the summit of Ingleborough...

Return on a different route to catch your bus or train.

- Route 1** Clapham Clapdale - Trow Gill - Gaping Gill - Little Ingleborough - Ingleborough 7km - 4½ miles.
- Route 2** Ingleton - Storrs Common - Fell Lane - Crina Bottom - Ingleborough 6km - 4 miles.
- Route 3** Chapel-le-Dale - Souther Scales - Humphrey Bottom - Swine Tail - Ingleborough 4km - 2½ miles.
- Route 4** Ribblehead - Ribblehead Quarry - Gauber - Colt Park - Park Fell - Simon Fell - Ingleborough 7km - 4½ miles.
- Route 5** Horton-in-Ribblesdale - Beecroft - Sulber Nick - Sulber - Fell Beck - Simon Fell Breast - Ingleborough 7km - 4½ miles.
- Route 6** Austwick - Crummack Lane - Crummack - Thieves Moss - Beggars Stile - Sulber - Simon Fell Breast - Ingleborough 9k - 5½ miles.

## Leeds - Settle - Carlisle trains to access Ingleborough and the National Nature Reserve



23 May - 17 October 2010

Take the scenic Settle-Carlisle line direct to Settle (for bus connections), Horton-in-Ribblesdale and Ribblehead to access Ingleborough National Nature Reserve. Trains run daily from Leeds, Keighley, Carlisle and Skipton and on Sundays (until 17 October) from Blackpool and Preston calling at Blackburn, Clitheroe and Hellifield.

**The Ingleborough Pony:  
Bus 832 Settle - Ingleton - Ribbleshead - Hawes**



The **Ingleborough Pony** is a Sunday and Bank Holiday bus service, linking villages along the south of the Yorkshire Dales National Park along the A65 to Ingleton then up to Chapel le Dale and Ribbleshead, to provide a friendly service for walkers to Ingleborough National Nature Reserve.

Named in tribute to the traditional breed of sturdy pony that once worked in the lead mines of the Northern Dales, or in packhorse trains to provide essential goods and services to Dales communities, **The Ingleborough Pony** helps reduce difficult and unsightly parking around Chapel-le-Dale and Ribbleshead, whilst making it easier to undertake linear walks along the magnificent Ingleborough ridge.

**Ingleborough National Nature Reserve**

Ingleborough at 2,373 ft (724 metres), with its striking flat summit is Yorkshire's most famous mountain. Its distinctive shape has been created by its limestone geology and the forces of nature - ice and water. This limestone rock is also responsible for the wonderful flower-rich pastures, which are at their most attractive on the Ingleborough National Nature Reserve, which covers over 1,000 hectares of the mountainside. Here you can experience nature's own rock gardens, the limestone pavements - a remarkable sight, especially during late spring and early summer.

Much of the area and its fabulous scenery are accessible by using public transport, making use of the area's excellent public footpath network or extensive open access land. The natural wonders of Ingleborough are here to enjoy, but treat this special area with the respect it deserves to protect this special heritage for future generations.

The greenest way to explore the Reserve and cut your carbon footprint is to travel to Settle via the Settle to Carlisle railway then either take the 581 bus (not Sundays) from Settle Market Place to Austwick, Clapham, or Ingleton to walk up the mountain or continue on the Settle-Carlisle line to Horton-in-Ribblesdale or Ribbleshead with a choice of magnificent footpaths across the National Nature Reserve or to the summit of Ingleborough, maybe returning to Ingleton, Clapham or Austwick to pick up your bus back to Settle.

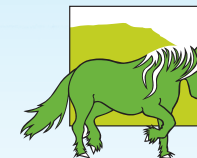
Alternatively, on Sundays park in one of the public car parks close to the main A65 at Settle, Clapham or Ingleton and either ride to the start of your walk on morning 832 Ingleborough Pony bus to Ingleton, Chapel-le-Dale or Ribbleshead, or set out on foot and return to your parked vehicle on the late afternoon bus at the end of your walk. The combination of bus and train or bus and parked car allows you to enjoy a full linear walk across the mountain ridge, by far the best and most exciting way of fully enjoying this spectacular scenery.

This leaflet gives you all Sunday and weekday bus and train times for summer 2010. You'll also need Ordnance Survey Outdoor Leisure Map OL 2, a compass, rainwear, warm clothing, food and plenty of drink. A good pair of boots is also essential.
