**Dartmoor National Park** is the largest and wildest area of open country in Southern England. Lots of people visit the National Park to enjoy the beautiful scenery and to recharge their batteries, but many come to get active! With over 450 miles (730km) of public rights of way, there is an abundance of walking routes to suit all tastes and abilities. Dartmoor also has a variety of cycle routes, both on and off road, making it as challenging as you want it. You'll also be guaranteed a warm welcome in a choice of village inns and cafes, with lots of places to stay.

**Trains Off Peak Day Return fares:** Bristol - Exeter £24 (tickets bought in advance for particular trains may be much cheaper), Torquay - Exeter £5.80, Exeter - Plymouth £7.90, Torquay - Plymouth £6.40, Plymouth - Gunnislake £4.80, Exeter - Gunnislake £8.50. On First Great Western trains, **GroupSave** allows 3 or 4 passengers to travel for the price of 2 adult Off Peak Day Returns and up to 4 accompanying children for £1 each return.

**Buses First Day South West:** Valid on all First buses and most Devon County Council supported services; adult £7.30, child £5.95, family £17.50. **South West Explorer:** Unlimited travel all day on Stagecoach, Country Bus and Western Greyhound buses on the day of issue. £6.50 adult, £4 child, £16 family (Up to 2 adults and 3 children) Note: Adult prices vary - on Country Bus £6 and Western Greyhound £7. **Dartmoor Sunday Rover** offers travel on a wide network of buses across Dartmoor plus train travel on the Plymouth - Gunnislake Tamar Valley Line and the Exeter Central - Barnstaple Tarka Line. (Also valid on some special trains between Exeter and Okehampton in the summer.) Prices; adult £6.50, child £4.30, family (2 adults and up to 3 children) £16.
